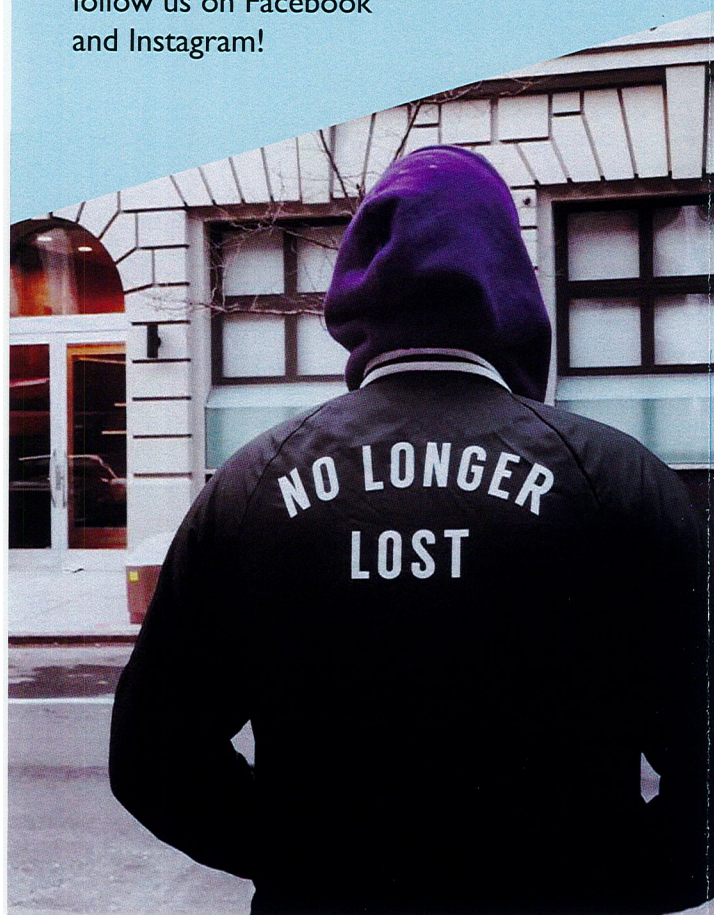

Our Mission

OffThe Streets helps people struggling with homelessness to get “off the streets” and into permanent housing.

About Us

OffThe Streets has no paid staff, no office, and minimal overhead. We do not rely on national, state, or local government money. We are operated by a dedicated group of volunteers and 100% funded by private donations.

OffThe Streets is a 501(c)(3) charity. All donations are tax deductible

Our local chapter (**OffThe Streets Middletown**) is affiliated with Seven Sorrows BVM Catholic Church and ministers to Middletown and the surrounding communities in Dauphin County, PA.




What We Do

OffThe Streets works with social service agencies in Dauphin County to identify individuals and families who have the financial means to pay monthly rent but may need assistance with up-front money for a security deposit.

OffThe Streets provides the security deposit directly to the landlord, which is often the only thing preventing someone from being housed.

Many people experiencing homelessness have lost most, if not all, their material goods. To help settle them into their new home, **OffThe Streets** helps to provide the basics: beds, dressers, chairs, tables, bedding, kitchen ware and other household items. Most of these items are donated.
